Doing this with care for our people, communities and the environment is at the heart of our work.


We're committed to overcoming the challenges of nuclear cleanup and decommissioning, leaving our 17 nuclear sites ready for their next use.



Cross-Industry learning impacts across several different areas:


Innovation and Learning - "...encourage and harness new ideas, including everything from radical innovation to incremental improvement, so the organization can effectively evolve and grow over time.."


Results

 ✓ In these areas of OH, there has been the greatest of all increase in score between the 2017 and 2021 surveys, both moving from bottom to 2nd quartile
 ✓ All 'OHI practices' influenced by cross-industry scores improved, 4 moved up one quartile

Costs: A UK view over 120+ years



Cost (£Billion)


