Today, nuclear power stations in England and Scotland are producing clean, reliable energy for our homes, businesses and public services, and ensures our energy security. New nuclear projects in England are training thousands of young people, giving them skills for life and new hope for the future. Young people from all over Wales are leaving home to find work at projects elsewhere. It's time to bring them home.

A new large-scale nuclear power station at Wylfa would be the largest inward investment in Welsh history. It would deliver thousands of high-skilled jobs on site and across the nation. It would offer good work for Welsh workers and Welsh industry for the rest of this century, and it should be just the start.

That is why in Parliament, I will support:

1

Progressing Sizewell C to a Final Investment Decision by the autumn of 2024, to ensure further orders for Welsh industry.

2

Another large-scale nuclear station at Wylfa after Sizewell C, with UK Government support to ensure the project gets built.

3

Advanced nuclear development at Trawsfynydd.

4

Maximising the UK's fuel manufacturing capability to meet increased demand from allies for current and advanced nuclear fuels.

5

Maximising the work for the Welsh supply chain on nuclear projects in the rest of the United Kingdom.

The nuclear reactors we build today will last for the rest of this century. They will provide our country with security and opportunity that will last for our children and grandchildren and generations yet to come, and the time to act is now.
